7 <sup>th</sup> June	Year 6 Online Event	During this online event we will introduce key members of staff for year 7 students and important information for starting at the school. You will also hear from our Student Transition Ambassadors and learn more about what life is like at Seahaven.
21 <sup>st</sup> June	Transition Activity Pack	The activity pack will introduce you to our teaching staff and give a taste of what to expect in each subject.
28 <sup>th</sup> June	Transition Information Letter	Information will be sent home containing the details needed to prepare for our transition, including working groups and timetables.
