#### Term 4 updates: Return to School from 8th March onwards

We have had a very positive start to the new term and are really looking forward to seeing all our students back on the school site in just over a week's time.

The letter sent yesterday regarding the first week's testing arrangements to support the return to school is here: <u>Testing arrangements for return to school</u>.

The plan for teaching in week 2 of Term 4 is as follows:

### Monday 1st - Thursday 4th March:

- 'Live' lessons via Remote Learning for all students as per their usual timetable.
- CWV groups for all year groups on site.

#### Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March:

- Education with Character day. A full programme of related lessons/activities will be provided for students to work on throughout the day as we had already planned. This will give a break from full online learning days and provide some time to prepare for the return to school. Details will be sent directly to students next week.
- CWV groups for all year groups on site.

In order to carry out the second week's testing, and to ensure a safe and COVID-secure return to school for all students, we will need to stagger the full return over the first three days. The plan for teaching in week 3 of Term 4 is therefore as follows:

## Monday 8th March:

- Years 10 and 11 return to school.
- Years 7, 8 and 9 continue Remote Learning and live lessons from home.
- CWV groups for years 7, 8 and 9 on site.



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# Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March:

- Years 7 and 8 return to school.
- Year 9 continue Remote Learning and live lessons from home.
- CWV group for year 9 on site.

## Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> March

• Year 9 return to school.

Therefore, on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> March, all students will be back on the school site for a more 'normal' school timetable (COVID restrictions will still apply including keeping to year group bubbles, face masks being required, limited movement around the school and staggered breaks/lunches).

Further details will follow next week.
