Educational Visits to Wakehurst Place Tuesday 17th or Wednesday 18th September 2019

The Science and Art departments has been given the opportunity to take our Year 7 students to visit Wakehurst Place (near Ardingly) on the above dates. Wakehurst Place is the tree section of Kew Gardens, and also houses the Millennium Seed Bank.

The visit is heavily subsidised by Kew, with the intention of educating children about the work that is done there. Due to the costs of transport we are looking for a voluntary contribution of £3 from each student. Payment will need to be made via our online e-payment system, Parentpay. Please make sure you complete all the permissions that have been requested. Should you need any assistance please contact the School Office.

We will be leaving Seahaven Academy at 8.45am and returning at 3.30pm, travelling by coach. Students will need a packed lunch (provided by the school canteen for those eligible for free school meals) and a waterproof jacket in case of rain. Students must be in school uniform, but may wear sturdy shoes (or wellingtons etc.) of any sort rather than school shoes.

All students are expected to take part. If a student's behaviour prior to the visit is poor, and we do not think that his or her behaviour will be good on the visit, we reserve the right to keep the student in school.
