RE: Period 7 for Year 11 GCSE Students

Following the announcement from the government that formal GCSE Examinations will take place for students in Year 11, we are looking to support students as much as possible during their last nine weeks of school. Today in assembly we have asked students what else they want, need or have not got that might help them prepare for the exams. We will be looking to provide these things to students over the next week.

The structure of Period 7 for the next five weeks until Easter will be changing. All students will be expected to stay in school until 3.50pm on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Wednesday and Friday there will not be any after school sessions. Students will meet in the main hall at 2.20pm, register, collect a drink and snack before heading to a subject specific session.

A summary of the sessions running is shown below:

Monday - English and Science Tuesday - Geography, History, RS and DT Thursday - Maths and French

To further support students, when they do not have a direct subject session, students will be given some guidance to support revision technique or have access to the computer room to work independently.

In recognition for the commitment and effort of the students who fully engage in the programme, we will run a reward trip following the end of the summer examinations.

If your son/daughter is unable to attend a session due to a medical, college or other appointment, please can you contact the school office in advance of the session, and we will record the absence accordingly.
