Year 6 Transition Information

I hope that this letter finds you well and, like us, your excitement of joining Seahaven Academy is growing. Over the next few months leading into September, we have a number of events and activities planned to ensure the transition process provides you and your child with as much information as possible to prepare them for the next stage in their school journey.

On Monday 7th June we will be hosting a live event designed to provide you with a range of information about our processes in school. During this online event you will be introduced to key members of staff, learn more about our pastoral structure, our safeguarding and bullying policies, hear from our Student Transition Ambassadors and learn more about what life is like at Seahaven Academy. On Monday 21st June, students will receive a Transition activity pack. The pack includes an introduction from each department team along with some activities to give you a flavour of what to expect in each subject area.

On Thursday 24th June, we are hoping to host a live event to provide final information about the transition week. We are hopeful that this event will be able to take place on site but are unable to confirm this until closer to the time due to the uncertainty of restriction that may be in place. We will communicate the final plans for this evening on Friday 18th June.

Transition week is scheduled for Monday 5th July until Friday 9th July. The current plan is for this to take place on the school site to allow students to get a real sense of the school, its staff and to familiarise themselves with the school environment. Should regulations change and we are unable to have students on site there will still be a transition week in a different format. This will be confirmed in a transition letter to you on the 28th June.


