Dear Parents/Carer,

As we begin a new term, we would like to take a moment to remind you of our school's expectations regarding punctuality, uniform, and equipment. We believe that these expectations help to create a positive and respectful learning environment where all students can focus on their studies and feel a sense of belonging.

Uniform: Our school has a uniform policy, and we expect all students to adhere to it. Failure to do so may result in consequences such as detention or suspension. Our school's uniform consists of:

- Unform black blazer
- Uniform orange, black and grey tie
- Uniform jumper (optional) with orange piping or Uniform PE Jumper with Seahaven Logo (From September 2024, only the Uniform jumper with orange piping will be acceptable as the main uniform and the PE jumper can only be worn during PE lessons.)
- Uniform formal black trousers or uniform black "Charleston" style skirt (knee length)
- White formal shirt worn tucked in with the top button done up
- Black formal shoes (plain, no trainers, boots, branded shoes, or cloth shoes)
- Black socks or tights

We ask that all students come to school dressed in the appropriate uniform each day. We also draw your attention to the following:

- Hairstyles extreme hairstyles, bleaches or dyes that are in clear contrast to natural hair colours are not acceptable or considered part of school uniform. Shaved patterns or insignia are also not part of uniform.
- Make up If worn, make up must be discreet in natural colours
- Jewellery One stud or sleeper per ear and a watch. Clear retainers should be worn for facial piercings. Tattoos are not permitted. Please do not get piercings where clear retainers cannot be worn immediately for school.
- Nail varnish and false nails are not permitted. False nails present a health and safety issue especially in practical subjects. Please do not get false nails that cannot be removed for school.

Any student arriving with piercings or nails that are not permitted and cannot be resolved immediately upon arrival at school will be sent home so they can be rectified.

We believe the uniform policy helps to create a sense of community and pride among our students, and we appreciate your cooperation in following it.

Punctuality: We expect all students to arrive at school on time and ready to learn. Being late to school and class disrupts the learning experience for everyone, and it is important that we all respect each other's time. If you are running late, please let the school know as soon as possible.

Equipment: We expect all students to come to school prepared with the necessary equipment for their classes. An equipment list for students can be found here: Seahaven Academy Equipment List. It is your responsibility to ensure that you have the necessary equipment for each class.

We understand that some families may experience financial hardship, and we encourage those families to speak with your community team for support. We have programs in place to provide students with the necessary equipment and supplies. We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining these expectations.
