

## KS3 Summer Holiday Tasks

Over the summer holiday the maths department is providing pupils with the opportunity to revise and get better at topics which we have covered recently.

We realise that we will not be available to support you over the summer and we absolutely do not want maths school work to be causing you or your family any stress or frustration. It is really important that you get some rest and relaxation during your holiday.

You are not expected to complete any more than 4 hours worth of work. This will be a different amount of work for everyone depending on how well you personally get on with mathematics.

If you are really struggling with a task and you have watched the video, please don't allow this to cause any disquiet in your household, you can simply move on to a different task and try that instead.

We are using the **Hegarty maths** built in revision features which will provide you with tailored tasks according to topics which Hegarty Maths has calculated you could do with a bit more practice on. It does this by looking at your results since you started to use Hegarty maths.

The 2 features are called: **MemRi** and **Fix up 5**. Keep track of how long it takes you every time you login and aim to complete 4 hours worth of work during the holiday. This includes watching the videos.

- Login to Hegarty maths
- Go to "Revise"
- Click on "Fix up five"
- You will be taken to a page showing you your "Fix up 5" results.
- Click on the big green button to start doing quizzes which are customised especially for you.
- Videos will be available as usual, to help you if you get stuck.

- Login to Hegarty maths
- Go to "Revise"
- Click on "MemRi"
- Click on the "Start Quiz" button.
- You will be given some mixed question based on topics you have done so far.
- If you get a question wrong you can click on the video camera icon and watch the video to help you.
- After you finish you can decide to start another quiz if you wish by pressing the button again. This will cause a pop up to appear telling you that it is best to spread your revision out. This is true but if you still want to do more on the same day then simply press continue.

Have a really nice holiday and get some rest. We won't be available to help you with your maths so please don't get stressed or anxious. If you find it very difficult, try a different task. If you have done your best to complete the work then that is great. Remember: No more than 4 hours worth.
