I am pleased to announce the launch of Values Days at Seahaven Academy, a two-day event scheduled for 16th and 17th July 2025. These days are designed to bring our school values of kindness, ambition, and confidence to life through engaging and memorable experiences for all of our students.

Values Days will consist of one day of external trips and one day of on-site activities at Seahaven Academy. On the external trip day, students will have the opportunity to choose from a range of excursions that will provide unique learning experiences outside of the classroom. For the alternate day, students will remain on-site and take part in various activities that promote teamwork, personal growth, and connection to our core values.
