Trip Information 2025-2026

Ski Trip- ALL YEARS 25th March-1st April.

Approximate Cost: £1175

The trip is open to all years and will be going to the MondoleSki resort Italy, https://www.artesina.it/ The trip will depart school on Wednesday 25th March and return on Wednesday 1st April 2026. Students will enjoy Ski lessons with professional instructors and allow students to see and experience life on the slopes of Italy. Students will stay in a Ski Lodge where meals will be included.

Dieppe Trip: Year 9 and 10 15-17th April

Approximate Cost TBC £250-265

Year 10 GCSE French and Year 9 students (30max) - 3 days/2 nights in Dieppe. Trip includes ferry crossing from Newhaven, accommodation and food. Activities may include a meal at a French restaurant, visits to Dieppe Town with opportunities for interactions in shops/cafés and using public transport, visit to hypermarket, evening activities such as bowling, a tour on the 'petit train' around Dieppe and new for this year a trip into Rouen, the capital of Normandy.

Values Days Trips-ALL YEARS 15th and 16th July

Approximate Cost £50

Our Values Days trips allow us to offer many external opportunities to live our values here in the UK. Most of the domestic trips will be under £50. We offer trips to a variety of venues including but not limited to: Brighton Waterspouts, Harry Potter Studios, London Musicals and Go Ape. The cost of these is calculated to include the cost of the coach and allows students to have some wonderful opportunities in the UK. We do provide a 50% discount to students in receipt of pupil premium.

Values Days- Year 9 and 10 Barcelona Trip July 2026

Approximate Cost £651

Following the success of this year's Barcelona trip, we are planning another visit from 13 to 16 July 2026, departing from Gatwick. To secure the best prices and availability, early booking is essential. The trip is expected to be popular and is limited to 30 places, offered on a first-come, first-served basis to Year 9 students interested in Geography as well as other students currently studying geography. The cost is in line with previous Barcelona trips and includes return flights, coach travel to and from the airport, transfers in Barcelona, bed and breakfast accommodation at the Generator Hostel, two evening meals (one at a local restaurant and one at the hostel), a 72-hour public transport card, and entry to a range of attractions including Sagrada Familia, Barcelona beach, the cable car (subject to flight times), Maremagnum shopping area, Barcelona Port, Ciutadella Park, an FC Barcelona tour, and a walking tour of the Gothic Quarter. Please note that additional meals and changes to the itinerary may occur depending on flight times and availability.

Disneyland Paris Trip ALL YEARS 15th and 16th July

Approximate Cost £500-£600

As part of our Values Days programme, we are excited to offer a trip to Disneyland Paris, which will include one full day exploring the Disneyland Park and another day discovering the sights of Paris. The itinerary for the Paris day is still being finalised, but it promises to be a memorable cultural experience. This trip is designed to celebrate our shared values through adventure, exploration, and fun, and will offer students a unique opportunity to bond, reflect, and enjoy two iconic destinations.

Duke of Edinburgh- Year 9 and 10- Multiple Dates

Approximate Cost-£250

The Duke of Edinburgh Award is a nationally recognised award scheme, open to Year 9 students at Seahaven Academy. The DofE develops student independence, resilience and confidence. Students enrolled on the DofE programme will undertake expedition training in late March, followed by an expedition weekend with overnight camp in mid-June. Our Bronze Award expedition is held in the beautiful Ashdown Forest. All expedition and camping equipment is provided, with the exception that participating students will need to bring their own walking boots or sturdy trainers.
