Scholastic Book Fair – Monday 20th – Thursday 23rd October 2025

Seahaven will be holding a Scholastic book fair from Monday 20th to Thursday 23rd October.

The book fair will be held in the library and students in years 7, 8 and 9 will have the opportunity to browse and buy books during one of their English lessons that week. Students who do not wish to browse the book fair will be able to make use of the library during this time. Year 10 and 11 will have the opportunity to view the books during break and lunch time.

Scholastic offer a fantastic range of new titles for young readers and teens, along with a range of stationery at pocket money prices.

This is a fundraising opportunity for our school library, as the Scholastic rewards programme delivers free books to the school on the basis of books sold at the fair. We have set ourselves an ambitious target of selling £400 worth of books, and if we meet this target, we will secure £160 worth of new books for the school library.

Two ways to buy at the book fair: Unfortunately, we cannot take cash payment at the bookfair.

You can pre-purchase a voucher for your child to spend at the bookfair at <https://bookfairs.scholastic.co.uk/gift-vouchers>. There is no need to print this book voucher. The voucher that is emailed to you will have a serial number. As long as your child has their voucher serial number and the name of the adult who bought the voucher, they will be able to spend it at the book fair.

Your child can also create a wish list at the book fair and take it home. You will then be able to pay for items on the wish list at <https://bookfairs.scholastic.co.uk/pay>. Your child must then return the wish list to school and collect any items that have been paid for.

If a particular book is in high demand and sells out at the book fair, Scholastic will be able to deliver additional copies, and your child will be able to collect their purchase on Monday 3rd November.

We thank you for your support of the Seahaven book fair and, more widely, for everything that you do to encourage your child's enjoyment of reading!
