1. Introduction

- 1.1 Uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of a school and setting an appropriate tone.
- 1.2 Our uniform instils pride; supports positive behaviour and discipline; encourages identity with, and support for, school ethos; ensures students of all races and backgrounds feel welcome; protects children from social pressures to dress in a particular way; nurtures cohesion and promotes good relations between different groups of students.
- 1.2 The Seahaven Academy (the “**School**”) student dress code is fair and reasonable, and the uniform chosen is practical, comfortable, appropriate and affordable. All our students are expected to conform to the dress code. We consider our requirements to be reasonable and therefore we do expect parental support.

2. School Uniform

- 2.1 Our requirements for School uniform are as follows:
 - Uniform black blazer
 - Uniform orange, black and grey tie
 - Formal black trousers or black "Charleston" style skirt (knee length)
 - White formal shirt worn tucked in with the top button done up
 - Black formal shoes (plain, no trainers, boots, branded shoes or cloth shoes)
 - Yondr Pouch (see mobile phone section below for further information)
 - School coat (no hoodies)
 - Black socks or tights
 - Black belt – if worn a belt must be plain black
 - Black Hijab – if worn this should be plain black
 - Uniform jumper (optional) with orange piping or new grey jumper with logo
- 2.2 Students must wear their uniform at all times in a smart, presentable manner, including to and from School. Uniform items must be worn as intended and outdoor coats should be removed on entering the building. Blazers should be worn around the School site at all times, unless permission is given to remove them.
- 2.3 All uniform can be purchased through our uniform supplier Intersport who were chosen as the best value provider.
- 2.4 Intersport can offer a ‘payment plan’-style option to parents / carers whereby money can be added every month to a gift card. These gift cards do not expire for five years and money can be added as often as needed with no minimum or maximum amount. However, once money is placed on to a gift card it cannot be returned and must be spent in the Intersport store.

2.4 The School blazer, jumper, tie and skirt must be purchased from Intersport. All other items of uniform are available from a range of suppliers.

3. PE Kit

3.1 The School's PE kit consists of:

- **Compulsory:**

- Black t-shirt with Seahaven logo
- Plain black football shorts
- White sport socks or black football socks
- Black jumper with Seahaven logo
- Shin pads
- Trainers
- Football boots

- **Optional:**

- Black tracksuit bottoms / training pants
- Leggings with Seahaven logo
- Black rain jacket
- Black base layer

3.2 Please note that the School's PE Department is passionate about students enjoying PE lessons. At certain times of the year, students will be expected to do PE outside and potentially in cold, wet and windy conditions. It is essential that students are dressed appropriately for these conditions. Some items of the School PE kit are optional but allows students to dress for these conditions however non-Seahaven Academy tops can be worn as a method of keeping warm but they must be worn underneath a Seahaven Academy top, be dark in colour and should not have zips or hoods.

3.3 All PE uniform with the Seahaven Academy logo must be purchased from [Intersport](#).

4. Mobile Phones and Smart Watches

4.1 All mobile phones must be stored in the student's Yondr pouch throughout the School day.

4.2 The Yondr pouch must be locked by using the locking station at the School entrance at the start of the day and unlocked when leaving the School building.

- 4.3 A Yondr pouch will be made available to all students for the 2026 / 2027 academic year but replacements will need to be purchased should the Yondr pouch be lost and / or damaged.
- 4.4 Each student is responsible for their own Yondr pouch throughout the School day. Students will be required to show their locked Yondr pouch at the start of the School day to their tutor, as part of the daily roll call uniform check. The School reserves the right to complete compulsory checks on students' Yondr pouches.
- 4.5 Should a student require access to their mobile phone for medical reasons, an alternative procedure will be put in place. If a parent needs to make contact with their child throughout the School day, please contact the main School office.
- 4.7 Smart watches are permitted to be worn by students but are not to be used as a mobile communication device whilst on the School premises.

5. Dress Code

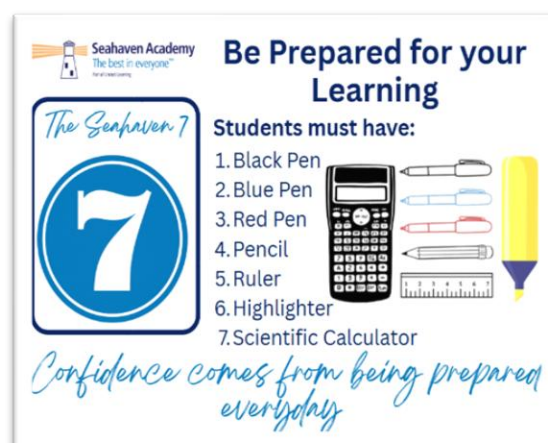
- 5.1 **Hairstyles** – extreme hairstyles, bleaches or dyes that are in clear contrast to natural hair colours are not acceptable or considered part of School uniform. Shaved patterns or insignia are also not part of uniform. Students presenting with such haircuts will be sent home and advised to dye hair back to a natural hair colour or have hair cut to a consistent length to remove the patterns or insignia.
- 5.2 **Make up** – If worn, make up must be discreet and in natural colours.
- 5.3 **Jewellery** – one stud or sleeper per ear and a watch is permitted. Clear retainers should be worn for facial piercings. Tattoos are not permitted.
- 5.4 **Nail varnish** and **false nails** are not permitted

6. Equipment

- 6.1 To ensure students are prepared for lessons, they are expected to bring to School (as a minimum) the following items:

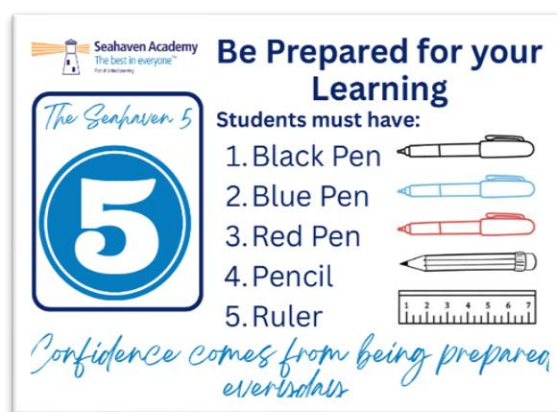
- 6.2 **Year 7** (for 2026 / 2027 academic year): must bring the **Seahaven 7**

- Black Pen
- Blue Pen
- Red Pen
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Highlighter
- Scientific calculator



6.3 **Years 8-11** (for 2026 / 2027 academic year): must bring **the Seahaven 5**, although they are encouraged to bring to School everyday the Seahaven 7

6.4 Students who routinely fail to bring this equipment to School will receive detention.

6.5 We want to ensure our parents / carers are supported making sure that second-hand uniform is available. If this is a request that you may need, then please ask your child's Head of Year for any second-hand uniform they may have that can be borrowed.

6.7 All items of clothing and equipment should be clearly marked with the student's name to help avoid loss.

6.8 In the Summer term, students must remain in full School uniform and will be informed on a daily basis during extreme weather of any allowances that are being made.

6.9 Any student arriving with incorrect uniform and / or piercings / nails that are not permitted and cannot be resolved immediately upon arrival at School will either be sent home or spend the day in the Refocus room.

6.10 Additionally, any non-School uniform items worn in the School building will be confiscated and handed to a Head of Year or a member of SLT (for avoidance of doubt this includes, but is not limited to, the following: jewellery, coats, black jumpers, phones, headphones / EarPods). Confiscated items are to be collected at 3.00pm from the uniform cupboard or the School office.
