# World Book Day Information for Parents/Carers – Years 7-9

World Book Day is on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Seahaven Academy have lots of exciting activities happening throughout the month of March to celebrate. The purpose of these activities is to support students to enjoy reading for pleasure and benefit from the world of books.

### Activities include:

- A World Book Day assembly.
- A lesson in the library to explore and borrow books.
- Year 7 students will be gifted a World Book Day book.
- Activities will be taking place in the library during break and lunch please encourage your child to pop into the library and take part.

#### How can my child take part in the readathon?

#### Option 2

• Read a book from the library, or 2 or 3 or 4! Students can read and return a book by the 28<sup>th</sup> March to receive **a goodie bag and be entered for the prize draw**.
